HNHC patients, who account for a large share of overall health care spending, often have social needs, clinically complex conditions, cognitive or physical limitations, and/or behavioral health problems. Research shows that complex patients are likely to benefit from a holistic model of care that addresses the social determinants of health (SDOH) such as transportation, housing, and nutrition, in addition to medical needs.</p>

Section II of the document includes guidance on the organizations responsible for reporting, the subset of measures for which reporting will be required by VBP Arrangement, and the changes to the reportable set of MY 2018 Quality Measure Sets (see the VBP Quality Measure tab)</p>
